The history of the house

Built around 1780, it was first a building that was part of a farm complex.

It was then renovated in the 1990s by a famous Zurich architect, who took care to respect the Provencal spirit, while bringing a touch of modernity.

Mistral, what is it?

In Provence, it is possible to meet a strong wind, called the Mistral!

Is it severe? No, you will survive!

But that's why you have to remember to close the umbrellas, and not leave anything outside that could fly away (including your children).

Another very important point is to remember to hang the shutters properly when you open them.



You are a smoker?

Please do not smoke in the immediate vicinity of the pool (to avoid burning the chairs and deckchairs).

Ashtrays are at your disposal on the terrace at the entrance of the apartments to avoid any damage.

Beautiful, but further?

More than 20 km away, there are also beautiful places to discover!

Roussillon (21 km), also part of the most beautiful villages of France with its extraordinary ochre colors and its surroundings nicknamed the French Colorado.

Avignon (29 km), city of the Popes and its Palace, its festival that we do not present anymore, its plethora of small stores in the enclosure of its fortress.

Lourmarin (33 km), nicknamed the little St Tropez of the Luberon, with its numerous galleries and small craft stores.

Les Baux de Provence (44 km), a magnificent village perched high up in the mountains, where you can discover its historic castle and its medieval activities, as well as its Carrière des Lumières and its breathtaking shows.

For the beauty of the landscape

Within 15 km of your accommodation, we have selected some of the most beautiful villages and landscapes to see!

Fontaine de Vaucluse (5 km), and its abyss, source of the Sorgue, but also source of inspiration for famous writers and poets. Lamartine, Chateaubriand, Stendhal, George Sand have stayed there.

L'Isle sur la Sorgues (5 km), a magnificent city that needs no introduction as there are so many things to see and discover...

Oppède le Vieux (10 km), will make you take altitude and will welcome you on the foothills of the Petit Luberon.

The village of Les Bories (12 km), with stone houses so characteristic of the region built with a technique dating from the Neolithic period.

Gordes (12 km), one of the most emblematic villages of the Luberon (it is part of the most beautiful villages of France), refuge of the artists but also guard of the traditions, also accomodates the festival of the evenings of summer where succeed one another comedians, singers, musicians, humorists.
